I. Old Business:

- A.** The committee approved meeting minutes for the February 6, 2019 Public Safety meeting 3-0.
- B.** The chief advised the committee of several issues relating to unregulated parking, improper signage and wayfinding issues that once addressed will help with parking concerns in the business district.

A. LPD 2018 performance

The Chief advised the committee the PD responded to 3215 events so far in 2019, made 46 physical arrests in 2019, and issued 218 citations for various offenses. Total revenue generated from fines, fees, and prisoner lodging in 2019 \$18,884 dollars.

B. Beerfest 2019

The chief advised the committee he received a properly completed Special event Application for the 2019 Beerfest event to be held on June 22, 2019, at the West Fifth Street Park. The committee voted to approve the event 2-0.

C. 9th and Walnut Stop Sign complaint.

The chief advised the committee of a complaint he received regarding the safety of the intersection since the new traffic pattern. A check of the data did not reveal any increase in accidents at the location and the chief personally inspected the area but did not find any issues.
