The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm

I. Old Business:

- A. The committee approved the PSC meeting minutes from the May 3, 2023, meeting.
- B. The chief provided the committee with a timeline for the roadway improvements to Susquehanna Ave. and Courtland Ave. The project is scheduled for completion in the second week of August.

III. Fairmount FD Report:

- A. Chief Butler reported Ladder 14 would be arriving on Monday June 12, 2023.

Public Comment:

Bernard Platt came to the committee to request copies of the two traffic studies which were completed in the summer of 2022 for the 300 block of Delaware Ave., after he was advised by LT Devlin that the studies were not completed. The chief advised Mr. Platt that the studies were complete and that he would be provided with copies following the meeting. Mr. Platt again requested official address the speeding problem in his block. The chief advised that he would meet with Mr. Platt to address the issues and report back.

Nick Amato related there are still issues with speeding vehicles on Oakland Ave. and that his neighbors were considering a petition for the borough to install speed bumps.

Dominic Frascella asked the committee to support the Safe Street for All federal legislation to make the roadways in Lansdale safer for pedestrians.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 PM.
