The meeting was called to order at 6:32 pm

I. Old Business:

- A. The committee approved the PSC meeting minutes from the December 7, 2022, meeting by a vote of 3-0
- B. Chief Trail advised the committee the installation of the new one-way sign on West Second Street at North Broad Street was completed however we are still working with public works to have the street marking painted.

II. New Business:

- A. The committee reviewed a Special Event Application for the annual Manna Race to End Hunger on April 2, 2023. The vote was approved by a vote 2-0 with member Currie Teoh abstaining from the vote.
- B. The chief advised the committee of several commercial vehicles getting stuck in traffic at the intersection of South Chestnut and East Main Street as a result of cars parking too close to the intersection. While enforcement actions have helped, the width of the roadway and sharp angle turns make it difficult for long commercial vehicles to navigate. Chief advised he would

work with our traffic engineer to determine the appropriate setback to accommodate wide radius turns.

- C. The chief reported to the committee there has been renewed complaint regarding speeding vehicles on Delaware Ave and Cannon Ave. The chief again related they would work to increase enforcement efforts and undertake several speed studies to determine the scope of the issue.
