- **Approval of Minutes**

- **Motion to prepare and advertise bid specifications for Phase III of the Liberty Bell Trail (Moyers Road Park to Wedgewood Park)**

- **White's Road Park Pool Update**
Work completed includes demolition, site work, and grading. Water features and the main drain have also been delivered. The project is still on target to be completed by Memorial Day Weekend.

- **Montgomery County Jazz Festival (Valley Forge Tourism and Convention Board) – Host Facility 9/15**
Courtney is coordinating with the Valley Forge Tourism and Convention Board to host a jazz concert at White’s Road Park as part of the Montgomery County Jazz Festival.

- **White’s Road Pool Building Front Exterior Mural**
The art teacher at Lansdale Catholic has provided options for the front exterior mural for the White’s Road Pool Building. This project will be completed by art students at no cost to the Borough.

- **Staff Training Update – Sam Brumagin and Seth Thomas**
Sam Brumagin completed year one of the NRPA Event Management School. This is a comprehensive two-year program. Seth Thomas completed his second and final year of the NRPA Park and Recreation Maintenance Management School. Congratulations to Sam and Seth!
